Once you are down it is a slow process to rehabilitate yourself, but it is being done and the tempo should increase next year.

The first team have two more matches to play. Next Monday they travel to Plymouth in the last of the League fixtures, and on Monday, May 6th, they will be at Salisbury in the Final of the Wilts Professional Shield. The Reserve team have one more game on Wednesday next, 1st May, when they meet Leicester City in a Football Combination fixture. The game will be played on this ground, kick-off 3.0 p.m.
