Accrington Stanley was founded in 1886 as Accrington. The Club was one of the original members of the Football League on its formation in 1888, and played in Division I until 1894. In 1919 Accrington was reformed under its present name and became members of the Third Division (North) on its inception in 1921. More recently Accrington have proved to be one of the outstanding Third Division sides in the North. They were runners-up in the Third Division (North) in seasons 1954/5, 1955/6, 1956/7 and 1957/8, a wonderful record. The Club's best record was in Season 1954/5 when they obtained 61 points and scored 96 goals in 46 games. Last year was their best defensive record when they conceded only 51 goals in 46 matches.

At present Accrington are without a Manager. The last Manager, Mr. W. Galbraith, resigned earlier this season. Previous Managers of the Club include Mr. J. Hackin, the ex-Oldham and England goalkeeper,

Mr. J. Pilkington, and Mr. A. Wade.

The visit of Accrington Stanley to the County Ground today should prove a very interesting one. The Club have a reputation of playing football on the Scottish pattern. The contrast in styles will undoubtedly be watched with interest, and we must expect a hard game.


