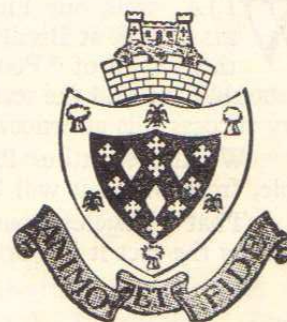

## Our Visitors

**S**WINDON TOWN were founded by the Rev. W. Pitt in 1881 for the young men of his parish ; they became a professional club in 1894; members of the Southern League 1894-1920, when they became one of the original members of League Division III. They are known as " The Moonrakers " (from the Wiltshire legend), " The Robins " from the colour of their shirts, or (like Crewe) " The Railwaymen." Their League membership is : Division III 1920-21 ; Division III South 1921-39, 1946-58. Last season they were fourth in the final league table.

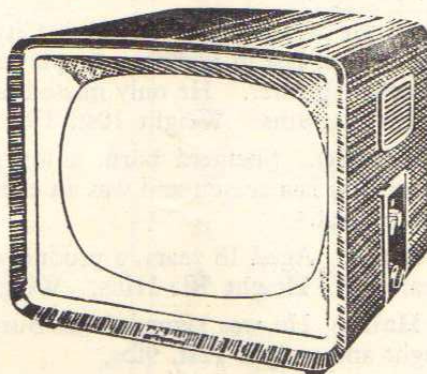

He is also a former professional sprinter. He only missed one First Team appearance last season and scored one goal. Height 5ft. 9ins. Weight 10st. 1lb.

**WALTER BINGLEY (Left Back).** Sheffield born, a former Sheffield Wednesday and Bolton W. player, he signed for Swindon last season and was an ever present from then on, 19 appearances in all. Height 6ft. Weight 12st.

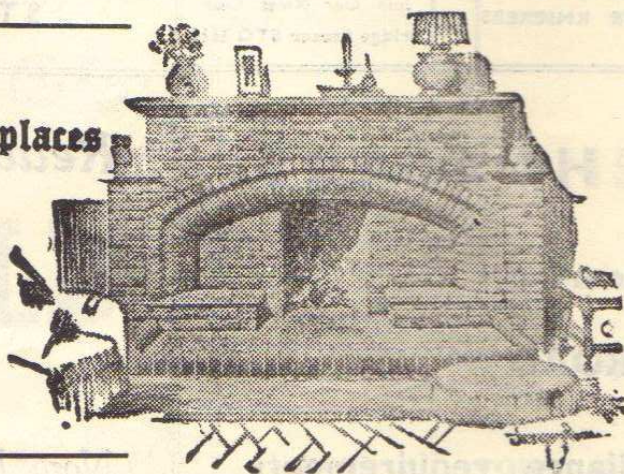
