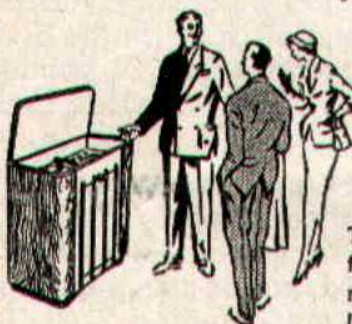

FIFTY YEARS AGO

Fifty years ago, during season 1909-10, Swindon Town enjoyed one of its best seasons. In the Southern League the first team finished in second position with 54 points from 42 matches. The second team, playing in the South Eastern League finished fifteenth.

During that season Swindon reached the Semi-Final of the F.A. Cup. In the first round they defeated Crystal Palace 3—1. The second round saw them vanquish Burnley 2—0 and the third round Tottenham Hotspur 3—2. Another win over Manchester City by 2—0 took them to the Semi-Final. In this match they met Newcastle United at Tottenham and were defeated 2—0. The Swindon team on that occasion was: Skiller; Kay, Walker; Tout, Bannister, Silto; Jefferson, Fleming, Wheatcroft, Bown, Lavery.

Following the outstanding run in the F.A. Cup, Swindon was invited to Paris to play against Barnsley for a cup presented by M. Du Bonnet. They won 2—1, both goals being scored by Fleming, and the cup stands today in the Club's Board Room as a proud memory to the achievements of the team of 1909-10.
