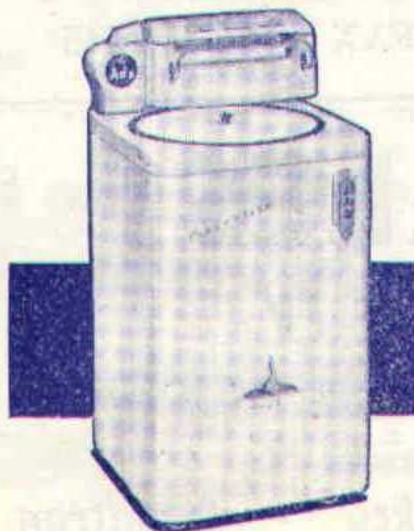
While we could not manage full points against Reading, our boys fought hard, and were, I thought, a trifle unlucky not to win especially as they had two penalties awarded against them.

WHO'S WHO IN THE SWINDON TEAM

Sam BURTON (Goalkeeper)—Product of local football joining Swindon in 1945. Played for Wiltshire Junior eleven which reached final of Counties Tournament 1944 - 45. Stands 6' 0", Weighs 13½ stone.

John HIGGINS (Right Back)—Signed from Hibbs. during the 'Close Season'. Born in Kilmarnock, he stands 5' 10", weighing 11½ stone. Previously he was with the Scottish Club St. Mirren.

Walter BINGLEY (Left Back)—Born in Sheffield. Signed in the early part of the 1958 season, making his League debut then for the 'Robins'. Walter came from Sheffield Wednesday, with Bolton previously. He stands 6' 0", weighs 12 stone.

Keith MORGAN (Right Half)—Another teenager produced through the ranks of the 'Robins' youth teams. A County Youth player, he made his debut last season playing a dozen League games. He stands 6' 1", weighs 12½ stone.

Peter CHAMBERLAIN (Centre Half)—Became a Swindon player in 1957 coming from Leicester City. Peter also plays in the forward line. Born in Bootle, he stands 6' 0", weighs 11½ stone.

Rex TILLEY (Left Half)—Second season with Swindon after a period of six years with Plymouth Argyle. Born in Swindon, he stands 5' 11", weighing 11 stone.

SUMMERBEE (Outside Right)—

HUNT (Inside Right)—

Ken MELLOR (Centre Forward)—Joined the 'Robins' during the 'Close Season' from Mansfield Town, converted into a centre half when he joined Mansfield from Leicester. He stands 5' 11", weighing 11½ stone.

GAULD (Inside Left)—

Arnold DARCY (Outside Left)—Born at Blackburn, joining the 'Robins' from Wigan during 1956 - 57 season. Played as an amateur for Accrington Stanley in 1952 - 53 season. He stands 5' 8", weighs 10st. 6lbs.

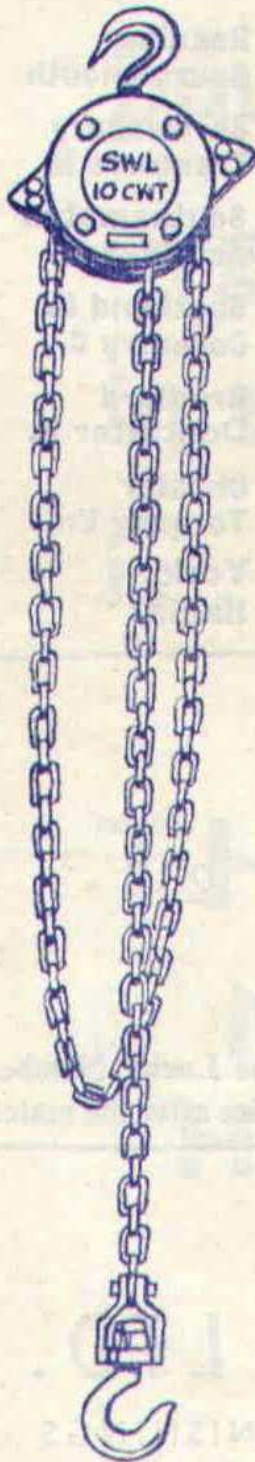
