### *Swindon's fine array of young talent*

**M**ANAGER Mr. Bert Head has been pursuing a vigorous youth policy at Swindon. A week ago his side contained seven teenagers and they took a point away to the strong Shrewsbury Town side.

This may not prove to be Swindon's year, but judging by the way the Swindon youngsters are shaping the day may not be far off when the Wiltshire Town will be having its first taste of Second Division football.

Swindon have been bombarded with inquiries from clubs ready to do business in the transfer market, but Mr. Bert Head is holding on grimly to the players he has unearthed, in the hope that they will bring success to Swindon.

Two players nearing the end of their careers helping to bring these young players along are goalkeeper

**Sam Burton**, who has been at the County Ground since 1945, and **Maurice Owen**, former centre-forward now playing at centre-half. Shortly after joining the club in 1947, Owen refused offers from Wolves and Arsenal.

Owen and Burton apart, Swindon must have one of the youngest sides in the Football League, as the majority of their more experienced men are in their early 20's.

Centre-forward **Ken Mellor** joined Swindon in 1958 his previous clubs being Mansfield Town and Leicester City. He has also played at centre-half.

## Swindon's seven teenagers

**Peter Chamberlain**, late of Leicester City and Liverpool born, and **Arnold D'Arcy** who went to Swindon from Wigan in 1956-57, are rivals for the out-side left position. Chamberlain has also played at full-back and centre-half.

Last season centre-forward **David "Bronco" Layne**, made a name for himself through his goalscoring feats. David was born in Sheffield and formerly played for Rotherham United. He was top scorer last season with 20 goals.

The under 20's who have already appeared in the Swindon side this season are as follows:

**Keith Morgan**, wing-half, a Wiltshire youth player who made his debut in 1958-59.

**Bob Woodruffe**, wing-half and a product of Swindon Schools' team.

**Michael Summerbee**, outside-right, made his debut last season, signing professional after being on the groundstaff. Michael was born in Cheltenham.

**Ernie Hunt**, inside-forward, also made his League debut last season, when he signed professional. Ernie is a local boy and he and Summerbee are two of the most sought after of the young Swindon stars.

**Clifford Jackson**, inside-forward, played his first League game when a groundstaff boy two seasons ago.

**Terry Wollen**, right-back and **John Trollope**, left-back, were drafted into the league side at the start of this season.

# OLD RIVALS FROM THE NORTH

**S**INCE its formation in 1958 the Third Division has been dominated by clubs from the South, but a number of Northern teams will be visiting Ashton Gate this season for the first time for many years.

These include Bradford City, who beat Bristol City 2-0 in the opening match of the season at Valley Parade, Chesterfield, Halifax Town and Tranmere Rovers.

Bristol City and Bradford City first met in the Yorkshire club's first season in the Football League in 1903-04, in the Second Division. Further games followed between the clubs in the First and Second Divisions. City were promoted in 1906 and Bradford followed them two years later.

When City were relegated in 1911 to Division II, the clubs did not meet again until 1923-24, after both of them had spells in the Third Division North and South, respectively.

Bradford left Division I in 1922, lost their Second-Division status in 1927, regained it in 1929 and stayed there until 1937. City went down after one season in 1924, returned in 1927 and remained until 1931-1932, which was when the clubs last met, 29 years ago.

## First visits to Ashton Gate

Chesterfield competed along with City in the Second Division in the early 1900's, but on being relegated in 1909 failed to gain re-election with the result that they did not return to the Football League until the formation of the two Third Divisions in 1921.

The clubs met again in 1931-32 in the Second Division, which was their last meeting.

Halifax Town and Tranmere Rovers joined the Third Division on its inception. Halifax have yet to gain higher status, but Tranmere had one season in the Second Division in 1938-39. Neither of these clubs has visited Ashton Gate in League or Cup matches.

Bristol City's Cup history includes matches with Bradford City home and Tranmere Rovers away. Bradford City were beaten 2-0 at Ashton Gate in 1919-20, and on City's only visit to Tranmere in 1932-33, they lost 3-2.
