#### BRADFORD CITY F.C.

## PEN PICTURES OF THE PLAYERS

#### MITCHELL DOWNIE (Goalkeeper)

Native of Irvine, Ayrshire. After service with Hibernian, Kilmarnock and Airdrie, came to Bradford (P.A.) in 1950 and was transferred to Lincoln 4 years later. Went non-league with Goole Town for a brief spell at last season's start before City signed him.

#### TOM FLOCKETT (Right Back)

Native of Ferryhill, Co. Durham. Joined City in the Summer of 1957 after 8 seasons with Chesterfield, his only other League Club. Captain of the side and missed only 6 games last season.

#### STAN STORTON (Left Back)

Born at Leighley, he toured Germany with the Yorkshire Youth Team and while with Hudds. Town Junior Team played for England Youth in Spain in 1956-57. Signed for City in July 1957.

#### PETER JACKSON (Centre Half)

One of the twin sons of City Manager. Came to City from Wrexham in 1955-56 season and turned professional about two years later. Native of Stoke.

#### RON MOLLATT (Wing half)

Native of Edwinstowe, Notts. A closeseason signing from York City with whom he spent five seasons following a similar period with Leeds United.

#### COLIN ROBERTS (Wing Half)

Native of Castleford. Started his career with Bradford (P.A.) with whom he spent nearly 6 seasons. Spent 3 seasons in non-league football before signing for City in June 1959.

#### DAVID JACKSON (Inside Forward)

A twin son of the Manager, Mr. Peter Jackson. In the last 3 seasons has missed only 7 games. Like his twin brother, first came to prominence with Wrexham, and turned professional in 1957.

Native of Keighley. Another product of the Junior side, who last season played in the England Youth Trial at Sunderland. Made his League debut last season when 16 and signed professional last May on his 17th birthday.

#### JOHN REID (Inside Left)

Born at Newmains, Lanarks, and joined City in December 1957 from Hamilton Accies, at a considerable fee. Topped the appearance list last season with 41 League games.

#### DAVID LAYNE (Centre Forward)

Needs no introduction to Swindon spectators. Since joining Bradford at Christmas he has scored 7 goals. This, together with 15 he scored for Swindon, makes him amongst the Third Division's leading goalscorers.

#### DEREK HAWKSWORTH (Outside Left)

Signed from Lincoln City in January of this year, he was originally a Bradford City player. He was transferred to Huddersfield and subsequently joined Sheffield United. Whilst with Sheffield he played for England 'B' team.
