

CLUB CHATTER

At the time of going to press Swindon Town are commanding a lead in the Third Division, and have been playing with a consistency that suggests they will take a little moving from the top. From reports received, Swindon Town have developed a flair for switching from defence to attack with the minimum of movement, and it is quite usual for us now to read that against the run of play Swindon pulled off another game. No one should let these reports kid one. Swindon Town have earned every point they have acquired, with a skill, and efforts which are quite deceiving. They have an abundance of ability in their sde, and when one studies their team, they must have the necessary fight to go with this ability. They are a young team, brought along gradually under the supervision of my old friend Bert Head. The achievements of Swindon Town have not just come to pass. They have been brought to a head by the patience of the club and spectators over a long term policy, which has called for both "give and take" since this policy was adopted. There are, according to certain sources, many people who would like to buy from Swindon, but Bert is lucky to have so many local boys in his team, and it is not every day of the week that these boys want to leave the place of their birth, especially as everything is rosy, as it is at the moment.

One particular boy in this team I have a great interest in (and it is not a buying interest) is Mike Summerbee, the outside-right of Swindon Town. Twenty-three years ago I had the honour of being best man at the wedding of his mother and dad. I played with George Summerbee at Preston North End, and it gives one a certain thrill to see a youngster such as Mike get on in the way his father always wanted. It is ironical that today he faces his Uncle Jack's team, when so much is at stake. That he will play his heart out, I know, and so he should, for my team will be playing theirs out to prevent Swindon Town getting even one point.

Welcome to all Swindon Town officials and

players. May the best team win, and the game be played in the sporting spirit this vital promotion clash deserves.


