#### Our Visitors . .

ATTRACTIVE visitors to Home Park this afternoon are Swindon Town, who have made a splendid start to their Second Division career. Although many people felt the Wiltshire club might have something of a struggle to maintain their place in the higher sphere, Manager Bert Head had confidence all along that they would hold their own, and his hopes so far have been amply iustified.

Swindon began with six successive victories, and were not beaten until their tenth League match when losing 0-4 at Northampton to the team which also gained promotion last season.

That game apart, they have lost only one other match. This

was at Preston, where they went down by the only goal.

On their own ground they have dropped but one point, when held to a 2-2 draw by Charlton Athletic. Their other seven Second Division fixtures at home have been won, and they have a goal average of 21 to 5 at the County Ground.

In away games they have won at Grimsby (2-1) and Portsmouth (4-1) and have drawn at Leeds and Manchester City, both these games being goalless.

There are eight local born players on the Swindon playing staff, of whom six are playing regularly in the senior side, and the

average age of the team is among the lowest in the country.

The two most experienced members of the side are centre-half Ken McPherson and centre-forward Jack Smith, both of whom were signed from other clubs.

Smith and McPherson are fellow-townsmen from West Hartle-pools, though they did not play together until they joined Swindon. McPherson, who used to be centre-forward, was with Notts County, Coventry City and Newport County prior to signing for Swindon in 1961. Smith was with his home-town club of Hartlepools United, and then had a spell with Watford prior to moving to Swindon just over two years ago.

There has not been a single change in the Wiltshire side's defence in League games this season, with Mike Turner a regular in goal, and Owen Dawson—who was signed from Portsmouth last season—and Norman Trollope at full-back. Keith Morgan and Bob Woodruff flank McPherson in the middle line, making a very strong department of the team. Trollope, Morgan and Woodruff are all local discoveries.

So, too, are inside-right Ernie Hunt and the left wing pair of Roger Smart and Don Rogers. The two last named have played together in every match this season, but Hunt has been absent twice through illness. Also an ever-present is right winger Mike

Sumberbee, while Jack Smith has played in every League match apart from the first, when John Stevens deputised for him.

On the two occasions when Ernie Hunt has been absent Bill Atkins has proved to be a most capable stand-in, and has scored a goal on each occasion.

Last season Ernie Hunt and Jack Smith registered 43 goals between them, a big contribution to their club's promotion effort, Hunt's total being 24 and Smith's 19. A third player to reach double figures was inside-forward Cliff Jackson, who was transferred to us during the summer, so that if he plays today he will be in action against his former club.

In the current campaign the goalscoring has been very evenly shared. Hunt again leads the way with six League goals, followed by Mike Summerbee with five, Jack Smith with four, Don Rogers and Roger Smart three each, Keith Morgan and Bill Atkins two, and John Stevens one. An own goal completes a credit total of 27 in 14 Second Division fixtures.

In addition to their League success, Swindon have done well in the League Cup, having won two games without conceding a goal. In their first match they had a splendid 3-0 home victory over Chelsea and then defeated Southend by the same score,
