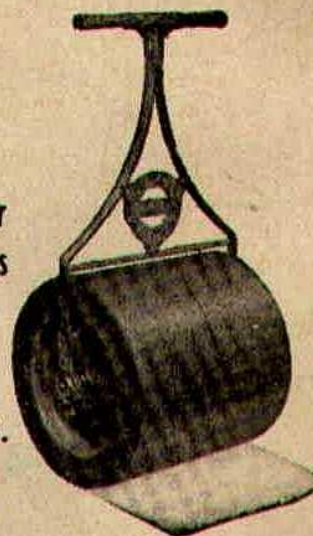

Our Visitors

SWINDON TOWN, our visitors today, were founded in 1881. Their home ground is the County Ground, Swindon, where the record attendance is 28,400 v. Stoke City (Cup) February 2nd, 1952, and the record receipts £4,089 v. Everton (Cup), January 29th, 1963. Swindon Town are new to the Second Division, for they only gained promotion last season being runners-up to Northampton Town in Division III, with 58 points.

They started their campaign in Division II with a bang, recording nine consecutive wins and also heading the table for a period. Since this fine start they have gradually slipped down the table, and they now hold a position in the middle of the table.

Swindon Town's fine achievements, have all been built up on a youth policy, which has paid dividends—ten of the side who gained promotion last season are local players who joined the club straight from school.

JOHN TROLLOPE, *left-back*. A local boy who joined the Swindon ground staff from school. Was selected for the First team at the beginning of the season 1960-1, when he was 16 years old.

TERRY WOLLEN, *right-back*. Another local boy who made his debut for the First team when 16 years old.

KEITH MORGAN, *right-half*. Team captain. A strong, attacking wing-half,

who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury.

ERNIE HUNT, *inside-right*. Joined the Club's ground staff from school. A member of the First team at 16 years old, he is a player of outstanding ability for whom the Club has had many offers. A local boy, he was top goal-scorer 1960-1 and 1961-2. Capped for England Under-23s during 1962-3.

MIKE SUMMERBEE, *outside-right*. Born in Cheltenham, he is another product of the Swindon youth policy. Formerly played at centre-forward, but has now made the outside-right berth his own. Another of the players wanted by several clubs.

ARNOLD DARCY, *outside-left*. Joined the Club in November, 1956, from Wigan Athletic. In spite of his lack of inches he is a strong forceful winger with a powerful shot.

BILL ATKINS, *inside-forward*. Joined Swindon from Aston Villa at the end of the 1958-9 season. A strong, ball-playing forward. He played several representative matches while in the Army. Since his demob. has quickly made the inside-left position his own.

KEN McPHERSON, *centre-half*. Signed from Newport County in August, 1961, he is a player with a reputation for hard work. Originally a centre-forward he has proved he has the ability to take over in defence.

JACK SMITH, *centre-forward*. Joined the Robins from Watford during the 1960-1 season. He was formerly with Hartlepool United. A strong, forceful player with the ability to get the unexpected goal.

ROGER SMART, *wing-half*. Another local born player who joined the Club direct from the Swindon schoolboys' team. At 17 he made the centre-forward berth in the Reserve team his own, later converted to a wing-half.

OWEN DAWSON, *full-back or centre-forward*. Signed during the close season from Portsmouth. Was a former Youth International.

MIKE O'HARA, *goal-keeper*. Joined Swindon from Luton Town last season and was a regular First-team 'keeper until he was injured at the end of the season.

WILFRED SHERGOLD, *outside-right or centre-forward*. Another product of the Swindon youth policy. He is fast and can play in almost any position in the forward line.

MIKE TURNER, *goal-keeper*. Joined the Club from Dorchester Town, whilst still in the R.A.F.

PETER LEGGETT, *forward*. A close season signing from Weymouth. He is a fast powerful player who can play in any position in the forward line.

TONY HICKS, *goal-keeper*. Another product of Swindon Junior football. Extremely agile and fearless. Signed professional September, 1962.

COLIN HUXFORD, *full-back*. Born in Stroud, Gloucestershire. A very strong and powerful player. Signed from Chelsea, October, 1962.

TONY HELLIN, *centre-half or full-back*. Born in Merthyr Tydfil. Joined Swindon at the age of 15. Signed as a full-time professional 1962-3 season. Another strong and powerful player. Has played in many football combination games.

WILLIAM HARBER, *wing-half*. Born at Hitchin, Herts. Joined the ground staff from school. A full ninety-minute player.

GRAHAM FRENCH, *left-wing*. Signed from Shrewsbury Town. Has gained a Youth International Cap. He is a fast, elusive player. Height 5 ft. 10 in.

ERIC WEAVER, *right- or left-wing*. A very capable amateur player. Two-footed, can play on either right- or left-wing. Height 5 ft. 7 in.

TOM HALLETT, *centre- or left-half*. Signed from Leeds United. Fast and tenacious player. Height 5 ft. 11 in.

ALAN SPROATES, *wing-half*. Signed from Sunderland. Ball-playing wing-half. Height 5 ft. 10 in.

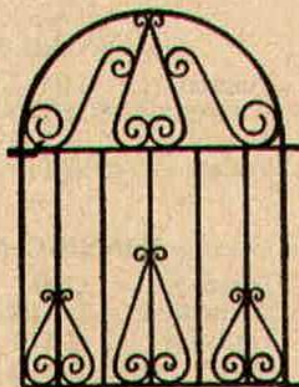
