of their players-Mike Summerbee, who went to Manchester City, and Ernie Hunt, to Wolves, so there is no shortage of money in the kitty for Manager Danny Williams to go out and get any replacements he feels he may need, and indeed, he has already spent a large slice of that money.

First of all he went to Halifax and obtained goalkeeper Pete Downsborough for about £3,000 plus Swindon forward Bill Atkins. Then he called on Coventry City and paid £5,000 for centre or inside-forward Ken Keyworth.

A week or so later Mr. Williams strengthened his defence by paying Middlesbrough some £15,000 for Welsh International centre-half, Mel Nurse, and more recently he has added power to his attack by handing over a fee of about £10,000 and obtaining the services of centre-forward Jimmy Lawton from Darlington.

According to my reckoning this leaves him with a credit balance of something like £30,000-plus on this season's transactions. Obviously, therefore, if the present combination doesn't look like clinching promotion then the club can be expected to delve still further into the transfer market.

However, don't think that Swindon have lost all their local talent or that they are not bringing on several more of their own discoveries just as good as some of those who helped shoot this Wiltshire club into the Second Division a couple of years ago.

Even now they have in their attack one of their own products who many people believe is fast developing into a finer player than any that have gone before. I refer, of course, to outside-left Don Rogers.

Donald signed for the Town at the age of 15. He made his Football League debut during that great promotion winning season and has already won England Youth honours. Doubtless, more honours are on the way.

A REMARKABLE RECORD

Today, however, another of Swindon's outstanding local discoveries takes the place of honour for this afternoon he reaches a remarkable stage in his career.

The player is left-back John Trollope and this is his 200th consecutive Football League appearance!

John made his League debut with Swindon when still only 16 years of age in the opening game of season 1960-61. In over five season since that debut this super-fit and enthusiastic professional has missed only two games, and those were two over Easter, 1961, when he was out with a pulled stomach muscle. In all he has appeared in 235 League

games, and that for a player still only 22 years of age is quite a total.

How fitting it is that John should be making his 200th consecutive League appearance against a side which is now managed by Ellis Stuttard, the man who as Swindon coach did so much to mould the many fine young players, including John Trollope, which the Wiltshire club discovered at about the same time in the late 1950s.

Swindon arrive here today bang full of confidence having won their last two games in a most convincing fashion. Last week they beat York City 6-0 (including three goals by Don Rogers) and followed this by halting Peterborough's run of success—beating them 3-0.

AWAY DEFEATS

However, both of these games were played at home, and the City can take heart from the fact that the Railwaymen


