CLUB NOTES

IN welcoming today's visitors, Swindon Town, we offer our congratulations to the many they have received already, on their brilliant feat in carrying the Third Division flag into the semi-finals of the League Cup.

Burnley are the next opponents and, such is their form at the moment that there must be a chance of them figuring in the showpiece final at Wembley.

Today, they come here trying to break our 100 per cent home record and, although we have been thoroughly briefed on the all-round strength of the Wiltshire team, our own record at Kenilworth Road commands great respect and no one has been able to lower our colours here yet.

Away from home, it is a vastly different story and we met with our fifth consecutive away defeat in rather disappointing fashion at Walsall on Tuesday.

What is giving rise to grave concern is that the goals, scored so freely at home, just are not coming on opponents' grounds and it is obvious that a marked improvement will be nescessary if we are to maintain our promotion bid.

Lack of success on tour is throwing even greater responsibility on the home games and the strain and pressure today will be tremendous.

At long last, our luck in the draw for the F.A. Cup underwent a change for the better on Monday when we were given ground advantage against the Athenian League amateurs, Ware, the little known Hertfordshire club.

While, there will be no disposal to under-rate them, it is perhaps stating the obvious to state that we should make progress without a great deal of difficulty, but nothing in football can ever be regarded as certain.

Tickets will be issued only for the centre stand at 9/- and season ticket holders have until 6 p.m. next Wednesday to reserve their usual seat. This may be done either by personal or postal application.

If the latter course is taken remittance must be enclosed, accompanied by a stamped, addressed envelope and first round slip from the season ticket book.

Some tickets will be available to the general public, who are advised to make early application, because fewer than usual are available because Ware have taken their full allocation



PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Peter Downsborough (goalkeeper). Born Halifax. Signed in August, 1965 from Halifax Town where he was a product of local football. A fearless agile player who has done much to strengthen the Towns defence.

Owen Dawson (full back). Joined the Club from Portsmouth in June, 1962. He was a regular first team player until he was unlucky to lose his place through injury. A fast tenacious player. He was a former Youth International. Born Hatfield.

John Trollope (full back). Born Swindon. A local player who joined the Swindon Ground Staff from school. He was selected for the first team at the beginning of the 1960/61 season when he was just 16 years old, and was ever present during that season. Together with his partner that year, who was also 16, they were the youngest full backs ever to appear as a pair in League Football. During last season he completed 322 consecutive League appearances for the Club.

Keith Morgan (wing half). Born Trowbridge. A tall fast attacking player who progressed through the Club's Junior teams after joining Swindon Ground Staff at the age of 16. He was formerly the Club captain but was unlucky to lose his first team place during season 1966/67 through injury.

Frank Burrows (centre half). Born Larkhall, Scotland. Joined the Club from Scunthorpe United for whom he played for three seasons. Formerly with Raith Rovers. A strong defender who has made his mark in Third Division Football.

Stan Harland (wing half). Was signed from Carlisle United in July, 1966. Formerly with Everton and Bradford City. He has been a regular choice at left half since making his debut at the beginning of the 1966/67 season. A forceful player who likes to go forward to back up the forwards in attack. Born Liverpool.

Don Heath (winger). Born Stockton. Signed from Norwich in September, 1967. Formerly with Middlesbrough where he served as an apprentice professional. A hard working winger who is also able to play in the inside forward position.

Peter Noble (winger). Blorn Sunderland. Joined the Club from Newcastle in January, 1968 for whom he played for four years. Prefers to play an attacking role.

Chris Jones (centre forward). Born Altrincham. A close season signing from Manchester City for which club he played in their touring team in America.

Roger Smart (inside forward). Born Swindon. Another local player who joined the Club direct from Swindon Schoolboys team. At 17 he was appearing regularly at centre forward in the Reserve team, but he excels as a deep lying inside forward. A versatile player who is able to play at wing half.

Probably the most sought after player in the team. He was signed by Swindon when only 15 and quickly came to the fore, Gained many England Youth International Caps and subsequently played in the England Under 23 International Team. Was the Club's top goal scorer last season with 28 goals.

Jimmy Giles (centre half). Born Kidlington. A versatile player who has played at centre forward for the 'Robins' where he proved to be a strong forceful leader, and also centre half where his strength did much to add to the defence.
