Following the disappointing result against Portsmouth I was forced to make changes for the away trip to Huddersfield, bringing in Geoff Roberts for his first game of the season and Paul Fletcher in place of John Byrom who was a late flu victim. Although we came away pointless our defence gained full marks for withstanding tremendous pressure from the Huddersfield attack which only broke through in the dying minutes to snatch victory.

Today at least one more change has been forced upon us due to the suspension for three weeks of Roy Greaves. He will miss four games during this period, three of them at Burnden and one at Middlesborough, a time when we can ill afford to lose any of our first team squad.

Already some pessimists are at it, following our two single goal defeats, in what is without doubt the most evenly matched league in the four divisions. My answer to this is that I do not intend going through another season like the last one, and neither do the players.

They have been given the incentives to do well and they will go all out to achieve their targets.

For the first time in years the attendance at Burnden for the reserve game last Saturday against Manchester United Reserves was almost 2,000 which is a tribute from you to the young players on our staff. With a full house at Old Trafford, we did not draw many supporters from the Manchester area, so we can only assume that word of our youngsters has spread throughout the district. At the foot of the Central League they may be, but one day in the not too distant future some team is going to take a pasting from these 16 year olds. Already this season Paul Hallows, Ian Seddon, Geoff Roberts and Jimmy Redfern have been on duty with the first team squad and two or three others are pressing hard for inclusion, which is the only way that a club can keep its senior staff fighting for places.

Finally two other 15 year olds joined us last week from Prestwick Star our Scottish junior club, and I welcome them to Burnden.

## SWINDON Facts and Figures

Founded as an amateur team in 1881, Swindon began to engage professional players in 1894 and was an original member of the Southern League Div. One until 1920 when it became a founder member of Division Three (South) of the Football League.

Swindon entered the F.A. Cup for the first time in 1907 and reached the third round. Three years later the ultimate winners, Newcastle United, put Swindon out at the semi-final stage as did Barnsley two years later after a replay.

The club gained promotion to Division Two at the end of the 1962/63 season, but after only two seasons were relegated. The Club again gained promotion to Division Two at the end of last season being runners up to Watford. They also beat Arsenal 3-1 at Wembley to take the Football League Cup.

Their F.A. Cup record as a Football League Club shows that they have reached the fourth round of the Competition nine times, the fifth round four times and the sixth round once in 1925.

Originally Swindon played in Green shirts, but have now changed to red, and many famous names have worn their colours. Harold Fleming, who gained nine English Caps, Billy Lucas, Norman Uprichard, Mike Summerbee, Ernie Hunt being some of the famous names of the past, while at the present time they have Rod Thomas and Don Rogers.

The County Ground has a capacity of 30,000 and the record gate stands at 28,898 for the League game with Watford last season.
