

The Editor's View - - -

Welcome to today's visitors Swindon Town who are, like the Wanderers, fighting hard to escape from the danger-area near the foot of the Second Division.

The sides last met in the 1970-1 season when Swindon twice came out winners by 3-0 at Burnden and 3-1 at the County Ground.

The previous season, the Wanderers were unlucky to lose 3-2 at Swindon with the Bolton goals coming from John Manning and Charlie Hurley. Earlier that season Swindon had won the Burnden encounter by the only goal of the game.

There was a gap to the 1964-5 season for the sides' previous clashes. Then Francis Lee (2) and Wyn Davies were on target in the Wanderers' 3-1 win at Swindon and a Lee penalty earned a point in a 1-1 draw at Burnden.

Today's game should be a hard vital contest with both sides looking for valuable points. The Wanderers will be seeking to avenge defeats in recent years in which Swindon have twice done the double.

The Wanderers have the boost of a new face in their side with the signing on loan, of Liverpool's Peter Thompson.

Thompson is an experienced winger who has a dozen or so England international caps to his credit.

He has been a member of England's World Cup squads and has seen League life at the top with Bill Shankly's side.

Swindon Town have been in the transfer news recently with Peter Noble, Rod Thomas and Ray Treacy all leaving the club.

Goalkeeper, Peter Downsborough, was born in Halifax his first club. He made 148 League appearances for them before moving to Swindon.

Jimmy Allan, born in Inverness, is Swindon's other goalkeeper and he had made 20 appearances in the first team before the end of last season.

John Trollope is a long-serving defender who is well past the 500 mark as far as appearances for Swindon go. He was born in Wroughton, and Swindon has been his only club.

Joe Butler started his career with Newcastle United, but he only made three appearances for them before moving to Swindon.

Richard Legg was born in Chippenham and Dave Moss comes from Witney. Swindon is the first club for both these players.

Chris Porter had recorded 28 appearances for Town by the end of last season and Charles Tuson, Trevor Tinson, Paul Fiocca and Roy Compton had still to make their debut at the start of the season.


