

# JOHN TROLLOPE

What a good feeling we all had after beating Lincoln City last Saturday - not only for the three much needed points, but the approach the team had right from the kick-off and the great way you, our supporters, encouraged the lads from the start. Lincoln suffered their second defeat in twenty games which is some record, and apart from some isolated breaks they had, we were on top for most of the game. Your cheers and appreciation of the team helped tremendously and I can only repeat my previous appeal to you - your vocal support is vital to our lads and if you will only do this tonight and for our then remaining two home games, it can only help them respond to you. The results of the game against Lincoln and Chester are important to us to narrow the points gap, and after Saturday we are half-way there, and if the players continue to display their determination and you with your vocal support, we will make it.

Our Reserve Team visited Oxford United last week and beat them 1 - 0. One of the main reasons I went to the game was to view the fitness and form of Andy Rowland who was playing his second reserve game after the injury sustained in the game at the beginning of January against Luton. It was also a real pleasure to watch the team play especially the younger lads giving one hundred percent effort. Had we been in a safer position in the League than we are, some of the younger lads who have played so well in the Reserves, would have made their debut in the first team by the end of the season. However because of the pressure which is now on us, it is impossible for me to take the chance that they richly deserve by putting them in a league game.

Last week Don's Midland Youth side played Northampton and were surprisingly beaten 2-1, I know Don was disappointed by the performance of his team which was definitely out of character for them and below their usual standard.

The South East Counties played at Luton last Saturday and drew 2-2 and Don tells me that it was possibly the best performance of the team this season and were unlucky not to win. This League is very important because it is from these players that next season's apprentices are selected - the lads who are the future of this Club.

Again, my thanks to those supporters who presented their cheques to me from their sponsored walks - and also to those who made the half-time collection on behalf of the Cooperative Fund. Can I once again tell you that I am looking for support by the way of sponsorship in the Swindon Marathon on 30 May - there are still some forms in the Club office. All money received will go to the funds of the Cooperative.

Tonight we welcome the players, officials and supporters of Chester to the County Ground, and once again to you, our supporters, thanks for coming and please, please help us like you did last Saturday . . . .

GRENVILLE MILLINGTON (Goalkeeper)
Joined the club in 1973 following spells with
Rhyl and Brighton. Was full time professional
until last season and was the supporters choice as
Player of the Year. Won Amateur International
honours for Wales.

PHILLIP HARRINGTON (Goalkeeper) Apprentice player who has not yet appeared in the First Team but already has represented Wales in three Youth Internationals and hopes to be in the Welsh Squad for the World Youth Cup finals to be played in Australia.

PAUL RAYNOR (Defender) Played his first game for the Club at Crystal Palace in 1976. Played 32 League games last season and notched one goal. Has scored eight goals in his career mostly from the penalty spot. Local boy who had a short spell at Shrewsbury before joining us.

TREVOR STORTON (Defender) Commenced his professional career with Tranmere Rovers for whom he made 100 appearances before being bought by Bill Shankly in 1972. Could not command a regular place in the 1st Team at Anfield and joined us in 1974 for £18000 which was our record fee at that time. Made 44 appearances last season but has played a total of 299 games for the Club.

DAVID BURNS (Defender) Product of the Club Youth policy who is a skilful player but his opportunities have been limited. Made 13 first team appearances last season and scored one goal.

JOHN COTTAM (Defender) Experienced player having made 92 appearances with Notts Forest and 140 with Chesterfield before joining us from Chesterfield for a fee of £12000 in July 1979. Made 42 appearances last season scoring one goal. Has made a total of 87 appearances with the Club.

PETER ZELEM (Defender) Another product of the Club as an Apprentice professional in November 1978 and signed as full time professional in February 1980. Made 2 First Team appearances last season but will certainly improve on that figure during the current campaign.



PAUL NEEDHAM (Defender) Joined the club as an apprentice player in June 1977 and signed full time professional in June 1979. Has been around for quite a time but is still only 20. Made 7 first team appearances last season but is developing into a strong tackling full back and will be hoping for a regular 1st team place during the coming season.

GREG MOFFAT (Defender) Greg joined us in July 1980 straight from School and is at present an apprentice player who is showing great promise.

BRYNLEY JONES (Midfield) A player who developed through our Youth Team. Made League debut at Swindon and to date has made 117 first team appearances. Last season he made 42 appearances and scored 4 goals.

STEVE LUDLAM (Midfield) A £45000 signing from Carlisle in July 1980 who had signed him from Sheffield Utd. Made 39 appearances last season and was joint top joint top goal scorer with 7 goals.

IAN HOWAT (Forward) Signed as full time professional in July 1976 but has not been able to establish a regular first team place. Played 17 times last season scoring 5 goals.

PETER SUTCLIFFE (Forward) Signed from Port Vale in December 1978 for £15000. Previous clubs were Manchester Utd and Stockport County. Made 28 appearances last season scoring twice.

GARY SIMPSON (Forward) Close season signing from Chesterfield for whom we paid £6000. Chesterfield was his only club and he made 30 appearances scoring 7 times.

TREVOR PHILLIPS (Forward) Signed in March 1980 from Hull City for a fee of £4000. Prior to joining Hull Trevor had made 289 appearances for Rotherham scoring 81 golas. Made 27 appearances last season and was joint top scorer with 7 goals.






