## **'As I see it'** **... Jimmy Mullen**

*WE welcome you here today knowing that we have secured a place in the second round of the Littlewoods Challenge Cup competition after beating Exeter City 1-0 on Tuesday night. After the 1st leg at Exeter we knew how difficult the return leg was going to be and this proved the case as, once again, Exeter packed people behind the ball and made it very difficult for us to play the type of football we served up in our games versus Gillingham and Bournemouth. The conditions on Tuesday didn't help, what with persistent rain and awkward wind, so it was a relief to see Roger pop up and record his first goal for the Club in serious competition after some excellent work from John Lewis. One of the most pleasing things about Tuesday was that we kept plugging away in a hard working manner and showed a lot of patience, which eventually paid off in our goal.*

*Turning to the Bournemouth performance, even though we found ourselves a goal down early on, we recovered quickly and established ourselves back in the game. # TODAY'S VISITORS

## Swindon T.

Swindon Town won their first Football League title last season as they swept to the Fourth Division Championship under the astute guidance of their Team Manager — LOU MACARI, the former Scotland, Glasgow Celtic and Manchester United star who, after being offered the position of Assistant Manager with Glasgow Celtic, finally settled for remaining as Manager of Swindon Town.

**KENNY ALLEN (Goalkeeper)** Born 12.1.54  
Joined Swindon Town from Torquay United in September 1985. The former Hartlepool United, West Bromwich Albion and Bournemouth player collected a Fourth Division Championship medal in his first season with the club as he made 40 League appearances.

**DAVE HOCKADAY (Defender)** Born 9.11.57  
The versatile former Blackpool player who moved to the County Ground from the Bloomfield Road Club in the close season of 1983 proved a revelation in the Full Back role he fulfilled in the second half of last season.

**CHRIS RAMSEY (Defender)** Born 28.4.62  
The former Bristol City and Brighton Full Back joined the County Ground staff on loan initially. Lou Macari secured his permanent transfer in December 1984. Chris, who suffered an unfortunate injury while appearing in the 1983 Brighton v Manchester United F.A. Cup Final at Wembley, made up for the disappointment of collecting a loser's medal by collecting a Fourth Division Championship medal with Swindon Town last season.

**TIM PARKIN (Defender)** Born 31.12.57  
Joined the County Ground staff from Bristol Rovers in July for a Football League Tribunal fee of £27,500. The tall commanding Central Defender had made 219 League appearances for Rovers. Tim moved to the Bristol Club from Malmö (Sweden) in August 1987. Rated at £50,000 by Bristol Rovers prior to his move to Swindon.

**DAVID COLE (Central Defender)** Born 28.9.62  
The Isle-of-Man-born Central Defender signed for Swindon in February 1985 on a free transfer from Swansea City. During the Wiltshire Club's triumphant season, the former Vetch Field Defender missed only two League matches.

**COLIN CALDERWOOD (Cen.Def.)** Born 20.1.65  
Without doubt, Colin proved to be Lou Macari's outstanding signing as he built his championship winning team in the summer of 1985. The former Mansfield Town Defender attracted a lot of attention from First Division Clubs last season with his brilliant displays.

**CHRIS KAMARA (Midfield)** Born 25.12.57  
Chris rejoined the Club for a second spell in August 1985 from Brentford for a £12,500 transfer fee. Absent through injury in the first half of last season, the former Portsmouth apprentice made 19 League appearances and one as substitute, scoring one League goal.

**STEVE WHITE (Striker)** Born 2.1.59  
Steve was surprisingly given a free transfer at the end of last season by Bristol Rovers. After scoring sixteen goals for the former Eastville Club last season, Lou Macari fought off opposition from several Third Division Clubs to obtain his signature in July.

**LEIGH BARNARD (Midfield)** Born 29.10.58  
Leigh recaptured the form that he displayed in his first season with the Club after signing from Portsmouth in July 1982 in the Town's championship season. The previous season, Leigh had the unusual distinction of playing for Exeter City on loan against Swindon, while the situation was reversed when the two Clubs met in the return fixture, Leigh then appearing for Swindon.

**ANDY ROWLAND (Defender)** Born 8.9.54  
Andy is now Swindon Town's longest serving professional, having joined Swindon from Bury in September 1978 for an £80,000 fee. Andy, who has now taken a backroom role with the County Ground Club, was restricted to 12 League appearances last season and six as substitute.

**MARK GARDINER (Striker)** Born 25.12.66  
Progressed through the Club's junior ranks to make his League debut against Mansfield Town on April 28th 1984. Despite the fact that Mark has been a prolific goalscorer at Junior and Reserve team level he has found his opportunities restricted to five League matches since his debut.

**MARK HUGHES (Striker)** Born 17.7.67  
Swindon-born, Mark missed the majority of last season with a pelvic injury. The local born Striker, who formed a prolific goalscoring partnership with Mark Gardiner in the South East Counties League,

**JAMIE REYNOLDS (Midfield)** Born 27.10.67  
 Regarded by many as Swindon Town's finest discovery in recent seasons. Jamie, an England Youth International, toured China during the close season with the England team. He made his League debut against Crewe Alexandra on March 16th 1984.

**CHARLIE HENRY (Midfield)** Born 13.2.62  
 The Acton-born former Club apprentice was a revelation in his Midfield role of last season. Converted from his customary Full Back position, he astounded everyone by becoming the Club's leading goalscorer with 18 League goals.

**MARTIN LING (Midfield)** Born 15.7.66  
 Moved to the County Ground in July for a Football league Tribunal fee of £25,000 from Exeter City. The St. James Park Club had set a fee of £115,000 originally.

**DAVE BAMBER (Striker)** Born 1.2.59  
 Joined the Club from Portsmouth for a fee of £15,000 in March 1986 after an initial period on loan.

**PETER COYNE (Midfield/Striker)** Born 13.11.58  
 The former Manchester United, Crewe Alexandra and Hyde United Striker was in brilliant form in the first half of last season, as he quickly swept into the lead as the Club's leading goalscorer at the end of October.

**JIMMY GILLIGAN (Striker)** Born 18.2.56  
 Jimmy was the first of Lou Macari's summer signings as he bid to strengthen his line-up in preparation for Third Division soccer. Jimmy moved to the County Ground in June for a £31,500 transfer fee from Grimsby Town. He had only been with the Blundell Park Club for one season following his £100,000 transfer in the previous summer of 1985 from First Division Watford.

**BRYAN WADE (Striker)** Born 25.6.63  
 Bryan made a successful entry into League soccer last Season from Southern League Trowbridge Town. To have finished with a championship medal in his first season of full-time soccer was beyond the former Bath City and Trowbridge Town's Striker's wildest dreams.

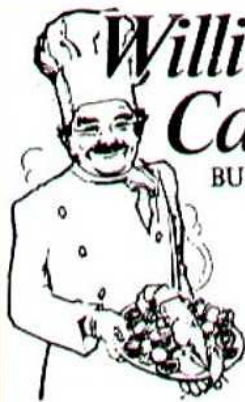
